

**Itinerary for our trip to Guatemala Tuesday, April 13th, 2010 until
Wednesday, May 19th, 2010**

Tuesday, April 13th - We arrive in Guatemala City .

Flights include Delta from Greensboro to Atlanta 6290 (6:10AM to 7:31AM) and Delta 693 from Atlanta to Guatemala City (9:55AM to 11:40AM)

Felix's brother-in-law will pick us up and take us to Antigua about 45 minutes away to the Burkhardt hotel where we will be staying and we will meet Felix there.

Wednesday, April 14th - in Antigua:

Visit Hermano Pedro* in the morning. In the afternoon visit with Felix's friend, Alba.

Thursday, April 15th – in Antigua:

Visit with Amy, Judy, Claudia, Fredi and their mothers. Also hope to visit the mother, Elena who had a baby born with cleft lip/palate that Amy and Claudia's mom helped. We plan to take Judy, Amy, Gregory, Anita and Mary out to dinner.

Friday, April 16th – leave Antigua on a shuttle (van) to Chichicastenango:

When we get there we will buy baskets, soap, and then we will add the specialty bottles and breast pumps that we brought with us, as well as the letter from Evelyn and us.

Saturday, April 17th – Chichicastenango:

We will go to ASELSI (Asociacion "Equipando a los Santos" Internacional, translated Association for "Equipping the Saints" International) to visit with Roberto and his mother and deliver six of Evelyn's Baskets to them. They were able to help ten babies born with cleft lip/palate in 2009.

In the evening we will have dinner with Sheri, a missionary from Winston-Salem, and her coworkers and friends, Kemmel and Lisa. Cathy, a nurse at ASELSI, will join us. We will deliver six Evelyn's Baskets to Sheri, Kemmel and Lisa for their clinics, as well as Cathy for her clinic.

Sunday, April 18th – We leave for Xela:

We will visit the Spanish School and meet with the family we will be living with for two weeks.

We will be going to Spanish School for two weeks from April 19th until April 30th.

Saturday, May 1st – Back to Antigua.

Sunday, May 2nd – Go to Guatemala City:

We hope to visit with Ashley Williamson who is working in Guatemala City. We also plan to visit with baby Joseph, who Felix helped as a result of response to the posters that we distributed during our last visit. We will stay at a hostel in Guatemala city.

Monday, May 3rd – Take the bus to Rio Dulce, a six hour bus trip from Guatemala, to visit Casa Guatemala Orphanage. We will stay at the Hotel Back-packers, which helps fund the orphanage. We hope to visit some of the babies who were born with a cleft lip/palate and their families there. Check out their website, <http://www.casa-guatemala.org/index.php>.

Tuesday, May 4th – Visit the Casa Guatemala Orphanage.

Wednesday, May 5th –

Thursday, May 6th – Travel back to Guatemala City; we plan to stay at a hostel.

Friday, May 7th – We plan to visit the Consulate to help Felix get a VISA, then go back to the Burnhardt Hotel in Antigua.

Saturday, May 8th – We will be staying in Antigua during the day and overnight.

Sunday, May 9th – Visit Freedom Through Friendship, a part of the Mayan Families Mission, (www.mayanfamilies.org). FTF provides food for needy families. We plan to attend Porch de Salomon's afternoon worship service.

Monday, May 10th – visit with Diego's family and then to Solola Hospital to review the use of specialty bottles. Return to Panajachel for the night.

Tuesday, May 11th – From Pana, take a boat to San Lucas. We plan to stay at the Hotel Iquitiu that Felix's family runs for his uncle. We will stay there until May 16th.

From May 12th – 16th, our plans are to visit Henry and his family as well as the Hospitalito Santiago Atitlan. In addition, we plan to visit Edison and his family and Albertina and her family. We are hoping we can take Father Greg and Father John with Felix's family out to dinner at Toliman Restaurant. We also plan to visit the family that we sponsor through CFCA**, Anica and Daniella. We are not sure

exactly what days we will be seeing the above people, etc. except that it will be in the May 12 -16 time frame when we are in the San Lucas Toliman area.

Sunday, May 16th – Go visit Teri at her Lake House and stay overnight.

Monday, May 17th – Back to Pana by boat, then take a shuttle to Antigua.

Tuesday, May 18th – Antigua. We hope to visit Casa de Fe, a home owned by Faith in Practice, (<http://www.faithinpractice.org/>), where families of cleft lip/palate babies and other surgeries stay while the patients are there for surgery. Faith in Practice is an organization that coordinates surgeries and surgery teams coming into Guatemala. We also hope to visit God's Child Project in Antigua, (<http://godschild.org/>), an organization that owns a home for abandoned and malnourished children in Antigua called Jackson House.

Wednesday, May 19th – Take the shuttle to the airport in Guatemala City for our trip back home.

Flights back include Delta 596 from Guatemala City to Atlanta (12:47 PM to 6:23PM) and delta 6416 from Atlanta to Greensboro (8:29PM to 9:50PM).

*Hermano Pedro is a hospital in Antigua where babies born with cleft lip/palate are nourished until they are healthy enough for restorative surgery.
